In accordance with California Civil Code section 4360(a), the Board of Directors hereby provides you with a minimum of twenty-eight (28) days' notice of a proposed change to the Portola Springs Community Association Rules and Regulations, Design Guidelines, and Delinquency Policy. The purpose of this notice is to offer Members an opportunity to provide comments and opinions on the proposed changes. The text of the proposed changes to the Rules and Regulations, Design Guidelines, and Delinquency Policy respectively, can be found in your Homeowner Portal in the Documents section in the "Proposed Rule Change" folder, for your review. Proposed deletions are noted as strikethroughs, and proposed additions are marked as underlined.

All Association Members are welcome to provide their comments to the Board before these proposed changes to the Association Rules and Regulations and Design Guidelines are formally adopted. All comments must be delivered prior to April 17, 2024, in order to be considered. Alternatively, if you attend the Board Meeting and provide your comments during the meeting, your comments will be considered by the Board of Directors prior to it making a decision on the proposed changes.
